Introduction to Relief Printmaking - Daniel Chiaccio 4.5h with Lunch break | \$95

A workshop designed for beginning print makers or artists with some experience looking to hone their skills. In this one-day intensive, students will create a one color relief print from linoleum. Students will leave with their own set of prints and knowledge of this unique and accessible medium.

Daniel Chiaccio is a printmaker and illustrator from Western Massachusetts. He has a BA from the New Hampshire Institute of Art. Daniel's work has been exhibited all across New England and internationally in Italy, Korea and Wales. **danielchiaccio.weebly.com**

B Zipper Bracelets - Joyce Weeks 1h | \$20

This one hour workshop will explore using zippers and zipper parts in making jewelry. In particular we will focus on making colorful layered bracelets. Each participant will leave with a bracelet that they made along with useful handouts.

Joyce Weeks combines the beauty of nature, inspired by her life in the Berkshire Mountains to create one of a kind pieces of artisan jewelry. Her designs include pressed flowers, zippers, vintage Lucite and buttons and semi precious bead necklaces along with jewelry for your hair. **southfielddesigns.com**

C A Moment with Clay - Washington Ledesma 2.5h | \$45

We will explore how ideas are translated into beautiful 3-dimensional objects, where space inside the object is as important as the space outside of it. Bring your questions to explore regarding techniques and uses of clay and kilns. Washington will also show some of the unique pieces which he creates to call us to our need to preserve the animals and the environment on our own planet.

Washington Ledesma, a successful artist in Uruguay, resettled in the USA where he became known for his unusual methods of decorating clay and his jubilant use of color. Now with a studio & gallery on Martha's Vineyard, he has taught at the Truro Center for the Arts and at the Featherstone Center for the Arts and was a Fellow at the Radcliffe Ceramics Studios in Cambridge. **washington-ledesma.com**

D Cuff It! - Shauna Burke 4.5h with Lunch break | \$95

Create a unique cuff bracelet while being introduced to the basic fundamentals of silver jewelry making. Learn how to saw, file, create texture and form metal – and finish up the day with a couple of unique, textured cuff bracelets in copper and sterling silver.

Shauna Blythe Burke is an artist and art teacher. She has lived and taught in New York and Florence, Italy. Her jewelry is inspired by the classic teachings of her time in Italy and by the urban environment she now calls her home in Brooklyn. **shaunablytheburke.com**

E Inkwash Painting - Nathan Carroll 2h | \$30

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This 2-hour workshop will be a hands-on look at black and white inkwash techniques. After some time to experiment with guided instruction, large papers will be provided to create a more singular vision that utilizes some of the techniques covered. Working with ink can be explosive and liberating, as well as delicate and precise at times.
